



James, Part 4: Genuine Faith is Alive

The following is a simple guide to help you incorporate Scripture and prayer into your week. Each day begins with reflection on a Psalm followed by the Scripture that was preached this past Sunday. Please set aside 20-30 minutes to prayerfully engage the daily readings and reflections. Be blessed!

Week 4 • September 28-October 2, 2009

Monday, September 28

Read Psalm 30.

Focus your attention on a specific verse, word, phrase, etc. that gripped you. Turn this verse into a prayer for your day.

Reflection:

What does this Psalm teach you about the person & character of God? What does this Psalm teach you about God's will for your life? Your families? Our church?

Read James 2:14-17.

Who in your life is God calling you to minister to this day? Spend some time praying for those whom you know God is calling you to serve (family, friends, someone in need, enemies, etc.).

Tuesday, September 29

Read Psalm 31.

Focus your attention on a specific verse, word, phrase, etc. that gripped you. Turn this verse into a prayer for your day.

Reflection:

What does this Psalm teach you about the person & character of God? What does this Psalm teach you about God's will for your life? Your families? Our church?

Read James 2:18-19.

Do you know the demons have the same beliefs that we do as Christians? The difference is that we love and serve the Savior while demons try and keep you away from Him. How are you doing in loving and serving God this day?

Ask the Lord today to give you wisdom in how you can live out your faith in a specific, concrete way today.
