Home Group Study Guide

Lordship of Jesus Christ – Romans 14:7-9, ESV

Summary of Today's Lesson: The third commitment we make as a Great Commission Church is learning to glorify Christ's Lordship in all of life.

Getting to Know Me: (these questions are designed to get your group started and build community)

Getting Started: (these questions are designed to "prime the pump" and get the group thinking about the teaching on Sunday)

1. What was one principle/idea/thought that stood out to you from Sunday's sermon?
2. Some say that you can have Jesus as "Savior" without necessarily having him as "Lord" of our lives. Do you think this dichotomy between experiencing Jesus as Lord and/or Savior is biblical? Why or why not?
3. What area of life do you most struggle with giving over to the lordship (control) of Jesus? Why?

Digging Deeper: (these questions are "text-based" and designed to help get the group talking about the Scriptures together)

Read Romans 14:7-9

1. Is there any area of our lives that does not belong to Jesus? Why do you think so many people live as if this is not true?
2. If Jesus were to visit the American Church today, what do you think He would say concerning our application of Rom. 14:7-9?

1. What area of your life do you believe the Holy Spirit is calling you to live in greater submission to Christ?
