Home Group Study Guide

The Worship of a Loving God – Psalm 103

Getting to Know Me: (these questions are designed to get your group started and build community)

1. Tell a story of a childhood experience with the 4th of July.
2. Who's your favorite historical American and why?

Getting Started: (these questions are designed to “prime the pump” and get the group thinking about the teaching on Sunday)

1. What was one principle/idea/thought that stood out to you from Sunday's sermon?
2. What does redeemed mean? How have you been redeemed and what have you been redeemed from?
3. Spend some time discussing the use and portrayal of “the LORD” in this psalm.

Digging Deeper: (these questions are “text-based” and designed to help get the group talking about the Scriptures together)

1. Vs. 7 Discuss specific deeds shown to Moses and Israel and how they reveal God.
2. Discuss vs. 14 and its implications
3. Discuss the emotions of the psalmist throughout this psalm looking at specific verses.

Application:

1. What is one thing I can change about how I respond to God in light of this chapter?
2. How can I let the description of the LORD influence my life?
